#### 第四部分： 读后续写（满分 20 分）

读后续写评分原则：

1. 本题总分为 20 分，按 5 个档次给分。
2. 评分时，先根据所续写段落的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次，最后给分。
3. 词数少于60词，从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时，应主要从以下三个方面考虑：
  - （1） 与所给短文及段落开头语的衔接程度；
  - （2） 内容的丰富性；应用语法结构和词汇的丰富性和准确性；
  - （3） 上下文的连贯性。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个重要方面，评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
6. 如书写较差以致影响交际，可将分数降低一个档次。

#### 各档次的给分范围和要求

档 次	描 述
第五档 (17—20)	—与所给短文融洽度高，与所提供各段落开头语衔接合理。 —内容丰富，所使用语法结构和词汇丰富、准确，可能有些许错误，但完全不会影响意义表达。 —有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使所续写短文结构紧凑。
第四档（ 13—16）	—与所给短文融洽度较高，与所提供各段落开头语衔接较为合理。 —内容比较丰富，所使用语法结构和词汇较为丰富、准确，可能有些许错误，但不会影响意义表达。 —比较有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使所续写短文结构紧凑。
第三档 (9—12)	—与所给短文关系较为密切，与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接。 —写出若干有关内容，应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求，虽有一些错误，但不影响意义表达。 —应用简单的语句间连接成分，使全文内容连贯。
第二档 (5—8)	—与所给短文有一定的关系，与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接。 —写出了一些有关内容，语法结构单调，词汇项目有限，有些语法结构和词汇方面的错误，影响了意义的表达。 —较少使用语句间的连接成分，全文内容缺少内容连贯。
第一档 (1—4)	—与所提供短文和开头语的衔接较差。 —产出内容太少，语法结构单调，词汇项目很有限，有较多语法结构和词汇方面的错误，严重影响了意义的表达。 —缺乏语句间的连接成分，全文内容不连贯。
0 分	白卷、内容太少无法评判、所写内容与所提供内容无关或抄袭。

### Text 2
